MR 4. Materials & Resources: Recycled Content	Sum of post consumer recycled content plus 1/2 of pre consumer content constitutes at least 10% (1 point) or 20% (2 points) of material in the project based on cost
MR 5. Materials & Resources: Regional Materials	Use of building materials or products that have been extracted, harvested, or recovered, and manufactured within 500 miles of the project site; a minimum of 10% (1 point) or 20% (2 points) based on cost of the total material value
MR 7. Materials & Resources: Certified Wood	A minimum of 50% wood-based products certified to Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) for wood building components
IEQ 4.4 Indoor Environmental Quality: Low Emitting Materials	Composite wood products must contain no added urea formaldehyde resins

MR 3. Materials & Resources: Sustainably Sourced Materials and Products	One point up to a maximum of four will be awarded for each 10% of the total value of all building materials and products used in the project that meet; Salvaged, Refurbished, or Reused Materials or Recycled Content or Regionally Sourced/Manufactured or Rapidly Renewable or Certified Wood and IEQ 4 Low Emitting Materials
IEQ 4. Low Emitting Materials	Composite wood products must contain no added urea formaldehyde resins
